In accordance with Papal Decree 17/2021, by which His Holiness Pope Tawadros II, Pope of Alexandria and Patriarch of the See of Saint Mark, has amended the Constitution of the Diocese of Sydney and its Affiliated Regions from one of a Sole Trusteeship to a Board of Trustees, a new Diocesan Board of Trustees for the Coptic Orthodox Church Diocese of Sydney has been formed and appointed by myself, as delegated by His Holiness Pope Tawadros II.
